



HOW TO SORT AND DISPOSE OF HOUSEHOLD REFUSE

- ◎Take out refuse to the designated site by 8.30 in the morning on the collection day.
- ◎No collections on Sundays, and the year-end and the New Year's holidays.

KEEP TO THE RULE OF REFUSE DISPOSAL.

CLASSIFICATION	SEPARATION-examples-	BEFORE DISPOSAL (CAUTION)	REMARKS
REFUSE BURNED		Kitchen waste Cooking remains, grounds, leftovers, etc.	Use transparent or translucent plastic bags or the like that contents can be identified. Garbage is put into a bag. A plastic bag transparent or translucent is used. Neither the bag which cannot check inside, nor the bag of paper can be used.
		Waste of garden Branches and fallen leaves, weeds, etc.	
		Waste paper (not recyclable) Used tissue, photos, disposable diapers with no filth, used paper, etc.	
		Wooden materials Chips, wooden products and timbers cut into pieces less than 50 cm long and 10 cm thick	
PLASTICS		Plastic containers and bags bearing the mark "プラ" Shopping bags, plastic seal bags for confectionery and frozen foods, and empty containers for shampoo and cleanser, etc.	Use transparent bags or the like so that the contents are visible, and draw the mark "プラ" on each bag.
		Other plastic stuff and products Vinyl bags, styrene foam products, polyethylene buckets and vessels, CDs and MDs, etc.	
PET BOTTLES		Pet bottles (polyethylene terephthalate) bearing PET mark Empty bottles for soft drinks, alcoholic drinks, soybean sauce, "mirin"(sweet sake), etc.	Use transparent bags or the like so that the contents are visible, and draw the mark "ペ" on each bag.
REFUSE NOT BURNED		Glass Glasses, aquariums, mirrors, cosmetic bottles, heat resistant glasswares, glass fragments, etc.	For items containable in bags, use transparent bags or the like so that the contents are visible, and draw the mark "X" for glass, china, leather, metal and rubber goods, and small-sized electric appliances on each bag. For items not containable in bags, deposit them as they are.
		China Cups, dishes, flower pots, etc.	
		Rubber Boots and gloves, etc.	
		Leather Brief cases, bags, boots, belts, etc.	
		Metal Pans, kettles, spoons, forks, wire hangers, etc.	
RECYCLABLE REFUSE		Glass bottles Rinsed bottles of beer, soft drinks, soy sauce, etc.	Use transparent bags or the like so that the contents are visible. Tie articles crosswise by item with string and deposit them in a proper quantity. Only articles contained in transparent vinyl bags are collectible on rainy days. Only articles contained in vinyl bags are collectible on rainy days, if any.
		Cans Empty cans of food and drink (beer, soft drinks, fruits, tea, seaweed, candies, cookies, etc.)	
		Paper Folded corrugated cardboard, newspapers, magazines, leaflets, inserts, milk cartons, etc.	
		Cloth Wearable clothing, curtains, sheets, blankets, towels, yarn, etc.	
NOXIOUS & DANGEROUS OBJECTS		Noxious items Dry batteries, fluorescent lamps, thermometers, etc.	Use transparent bags or the like so that the contents can be identified and mark the bags containing dangerous or noxious objects with "キ".
		Dangerous items Lighters, cutlery, table gas cylinders, sprays, etc.
